

## **Financial and Institutional Stabilization**

**Financial and Institutional Stabilization** grants are offered in collaboration with the New Jersey Cultural Trust. This program provides Cultural Trust grants for projects that help organizations increase their financial and operational stability and build their capacity. The NJSCA designs and manages the program that solicits and reviews applications from arts organizations and recommends awards to the Cultural Trust. To be eligible an organization first be designated as "qualified" by the New Jersey Cultural Trust.

### **Eligibility Criteria**

To be eligible for funds, an organization must be a New Jersey-based, nonprofit organization (no schools, units of government or religious organizations) that has been qualified by the Cultural Trust. Applications for qualification are available from the Cultural Trust [web site](#) or from its office by calling 609.984.6767. In order to become qualified, an organization must also demonstrate that it:

- Fulfills an arts mission through active programs and services
- Has been in operation for a minimum of 4 years
- Is tax-exempt
- Has a functioning board that provides financial oversight to the standards set by the Cultural Trust
